## The Goal of Deaf Evangelism Leadership Seminar

*To train and equip men and women for effective evangelical ministry in their communities*

Classes will provide question and answer sessions for deaf leaders, ministers, bible teachers, state coordinators, and local deaf ministry coordinators. Spouses of the participants are welcome to attend.

The forms of instruction include hands on training, ASL, and visual aids which include marker boards, overhead projectors, and PowerPoint presentations. Our goal is to meet each student's learning style as much as possible.

### Seminar Schedule

The seminar will be a four day event. Classes will begin with prayer at 8:30 am and will conclude at 4pm.

## Curriculum

**History of the Bible** Participants will be exposed to a catalog of stories of the Bible highlighting many of the major men, women, events, and geographical points of interest. Participants will see people and facts presented in chronological order and patterns of geographical movement as the Bible unfolds from the Old Testament to the New Testament.

**Reliability of the Bible** The participants will study a summary of documentation of historical evidence of the Christian faith. This will provide a base for them to be confident in outreach endeavors as they share the truths of the Bible in their communities.

**Basic Pentecostal Doctrine** The participants will review basic teachings that define the Pentecostal experience. This will give a strong foundation for understanding and proclaiming the Word of God in its simplicity.

**Oneness** The participants will be presented with fundamental Bible truths which lead to the revelation of the oneness of God and the absolute deity of Jesus Christ.

**Pcminister.com** The participants will receive information about this program. It is one of the paths to getting a ministerial license. We will explore other means of becoming licensed. (ie. Purpose Institute)

**Mechanics of Prayer** The participants will examine the basic passage of the Lord's prayer as the principle to the mechanics of prayer. Afterward, the class will discuss the application to their own lives...taking it to a deeper level.

**Meet the UPCI** The participants will be exposed to the doctrinal position, purpose, and organizational function of the United Pentecostal Church International.

**Minister's Manual** The participants will study the UPCI Minister's manual.

**Delivery Modes** The participants will study the various methods or modes of preaching and how to be effective in communicating God's word.

**Effective Ministry** the participants will learn the art of effective soul winning, the personal touch, manners, and effective communication. These tools will help participants encourage spiritual growth in people by teaching effectively and leading by example.
